CONTACT THE CURATOR

At the request of the Exhibition Curator, all the artists are required to send an e-mail to acknowledge that they have read and understood the information contained in this notification. Contact the Curator at jvargas898@earthlink.net at your earliest convenience.

DELIVERY OF ARTWORK

Please **deliver your artwork** on **Sunday**, **February 1**, **2015** (1-3 **PM**). Late deliveries will not be accepted. Shipping/delivery of artwork to and from the Bath House is the responsibility of the artist.

If you are shipping your artwork, please schedule your delivery accordingly so that we receive your artwork in a timely manner. Also, don't forget to include sufficient postage for the return of your artwork inside your package so we can return your artwork.

Art must be suitable for hanging. The exhibition curator will charge a maintenance fee of \$10 to artists whose work is not ready for hanging/displaying.

RESUME / ARTISTS STATEMENTS

Please provide us with a copy of your **resume and/or artist statement** when you drop off or ship your artwork. Many of our visitors like to read about the artists and their creations.

PUBLICITY

Publicity for the exhibition is done primarily online, via electronic newsletters and electronic postcards.

EXHIBITION DATES

The exhibition runs from February 7 to March 7, 2015.

RECEPTION

An **opening reception with the artists** will take place on **Saturday**, **February 7**, **2015** from 7 to 9 PM. The reception is free and open to the public.

The Bath House provides some food for the reception; however, artists are encouraged to bring in a favorite dish or beverage (non-alcoholic) to share if they so desire.

PICKING UP ARTWORK

After the show closes, artists must **pick up** their artwork promptly on **Sunday**, **March 8**, **2015 (11 AM-1 PM)**. Artwork will not be insured past this date. A storage fee will be charged to artists who do not pick up artwork on time.

INSURANCE

The City of Dallas Office of Cultural Affairs will provide insurance on most works of art. In some cases, however, the City of Dallas may refuse to insure certain pieces of art. The Cultural Center Manager will conduct an inspection of the work of art to determine if it will be insured. Artists have the option to purchase their own insurance separately. While on exhibition, the artwork will be given all reasonable care. The insurance coverage will not be in effect during shipping of artwork.

ART SALES

The Bath House Cultural Center Advisory Council requests a 14% commission on all art sold during the exhibition. Transactions for the purchase of artwork shall be directly between the purchaser and the artist or his/her official agent.

POLICY OF EXHIBITIONS

Submission of entries and participation in the exhibition constitutes agreement to the conditions set forth in this document and in the Bath House Cultural Center's Policy for Exhibitions (visit http://www.bathhousemedia.com/docs/exhibitionpolicy.html to review policy). Printed copies of the policy may be obtained from the Bath House upon request.
